
# SONA COLLEGE OF TECHNOLOGY Department of Science and Humanities Alumni Survey Analysis Report 2022-23







accessibility of reference books. The students were also satisfied that the course helped in strengthening their knowledge and developing their personalities.


#### **DEPARTMENT OF MATHEMATICS**





On an average 92% students are Excellent, 5% are very good and 3% are satisfactory. It shows that alumni were highly satisfied with our content of the syllabi.


#### IV. Parent's Feedback:





Computer Science and Engineering.





- As per feedback, the feasibility of inclusion of contents will be analyzed and included if necessary.




